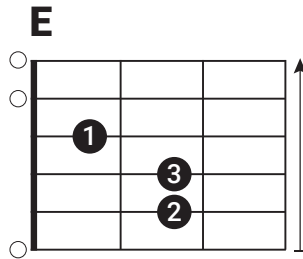
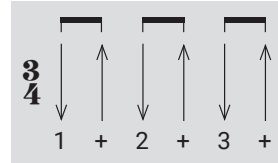

Der folgende Song steht im 3/4-Takt. Statt wie bisher vier Abschlüsse gibt es jetzt nur drei Abschlüsse.



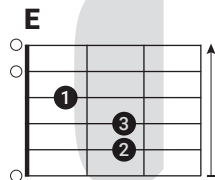
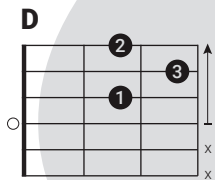
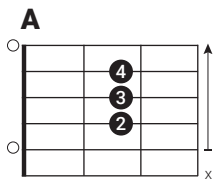
